


MAP OF JEONJU CITY

Jeonju Hanji Culture Festival

- Venue** Korea Traditional Culture Center, Jeonju
- The Jeonju Hanji Culture Festival aims to inform the world of the beauty and excellence of Jeonju Hanji (traditional Korean paper handicrafts from mulberry trees) and to enjoy and use it in our daily lives, as examples of artwork and cultural products.



Jeonju International Film Festival

Jeonju Bibimbap

Jeonju Bibimbap is made with rice cooked with bean sprouts, is considered one of Jeonju's "10 tastes" including many different egg garnishes, greens, pine nuts, chestnuts, walnuts, and other fresh seasonal vegetables. It is a staple health food that is full of vitamins and minerals. It is enjoyed by people from all around the world, and is regarded as a complete meal that contains the wisdom of our ancestors and the principles of the science.



Soondae Gukbap

It is a soup in the form of soup made by boiling pork bones and adding noodles to the broth. Soondae soup basically uses pig liver, and intestines such as yeomjong (pig's heart) encasing intestines. Soondae is a special food that is enjoyed all over Korea, and the method and shape of making it differ in each region. Jeonju uses soon-daeg (soup made by merging green noodles and rice with chabokdae and suri).



Jeonju Kongnamulgub (bean sprout and rice soup)

There is a soup made with rice and bean sprouts in a tub-like pot that is pot and boiled with various spices, and this is called "Southern Market Style Rice Soup." These two types of rice soup are cheap, so they are used as temporary relief soup for drivers, lunch for salaried workers, and a simple meal for families.



Jeonju Hanjeongguk

It is not only the richness of the food, but also the beautiful taste that satisfies the taste buds of gourmets. Jeonju's "10 tastes", which constitute Jeonju Hanjeongguk, is a treasure trove of traditional food culture heritage. The taste and dignity of the Jeonju Korean meal is surprisingly delicious, and will have you coming back for more. Its taste is unique and its quality is attractive.



Jeonju Home Meal Baekban

Baekban is a Korean dish that consists of rice with 100 side dishes. It is an exaggeration to say that Jeonju is famous for its variety of side dishes. This is one reason why a trip to Jeonju is a joyful experience. Jeonju was once located in the Jeongjuong Fortress, where the Governor of Jeolla Province resided. There are still many Baekban restaurants that have inherited the tradition.



A Table of Jeonju Makgeolli

It is one of the top three rice wines in Korea, and it is a sidekick that will satisfy the taste buds of those who love traditional Korean drinks. A Korean drink sidekick, which is enjoyed by the younger generation, is Jeonju Makgeolli. Jeonju Makgeolli is a traditional Korean drink, and it is a treasure trove of traditional food culture heritage. Deokjin District

Deokjin Park, which surrounds Deokjin Lake, is the perfect spot for visitors to take a leisurely stroll and enjoy music fountains and laser shows in spring, summer and fall. At the adjacent Jeonju Zoo, visitors can catch sight of a total of 103 kinds of animals, including rare ones, such as Asiatic black bears and pygmy, while at the nearby Patjuk Contemporary Arts Factory, which was created by completely renovating old abandoned buildings into a new cultural landmark, you can view exhibitions by various artists and a new cultural complex.




Hanok Stay

Public Bicycle Rental Information in Jeonju City

Rental Hours

- April, May, September, October: 08:00 ~ 18:00
- Summer season (June to August): 08:00 ~ 19:00
- Winter season (March, November, December): 10:00 ~ 17:00
- Closed every Monday and on Chuseok holidays (also closed during January and February)

Rental Eligibility

- Anyone who is allowed to operate a bicycle (licenseless users under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a guardian)
- Rental fee: 1000 won (after the operating hours of the rental facility)
- Conditions for rental: identity verification with a mobile phone

Rental Restrictions

- Anyone who cannot provide verification via their mobile phone
- Anyone who does not accommodate the staff's request for cooperation
- Anyone who is mentally and physically uncontrollable, or under the influence of alcohol
- Anyone who has returned the bicycle late, without a valid reason
- When riding a bicycle is dangerous due to bad weather conditions

How to Return Bicycles

- Make sure to return your bicycle after checking with the staff when the rental period
- Rental and return are possible at any public bicycle rental office.
