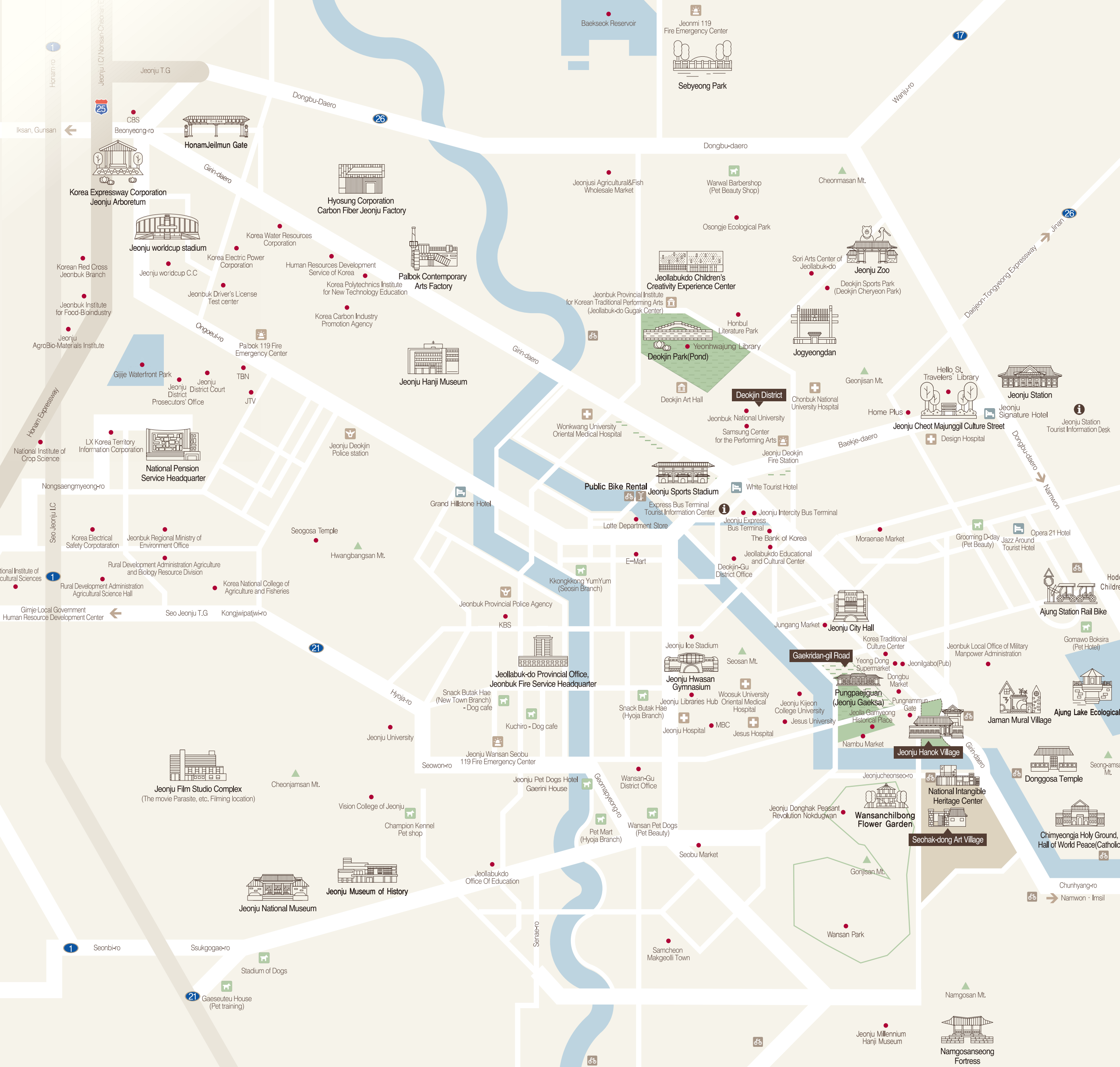


MAP OF JEONJU CITY

Here you can experience the cultural heritage of Jeonbuk, in addition to our children's museum.



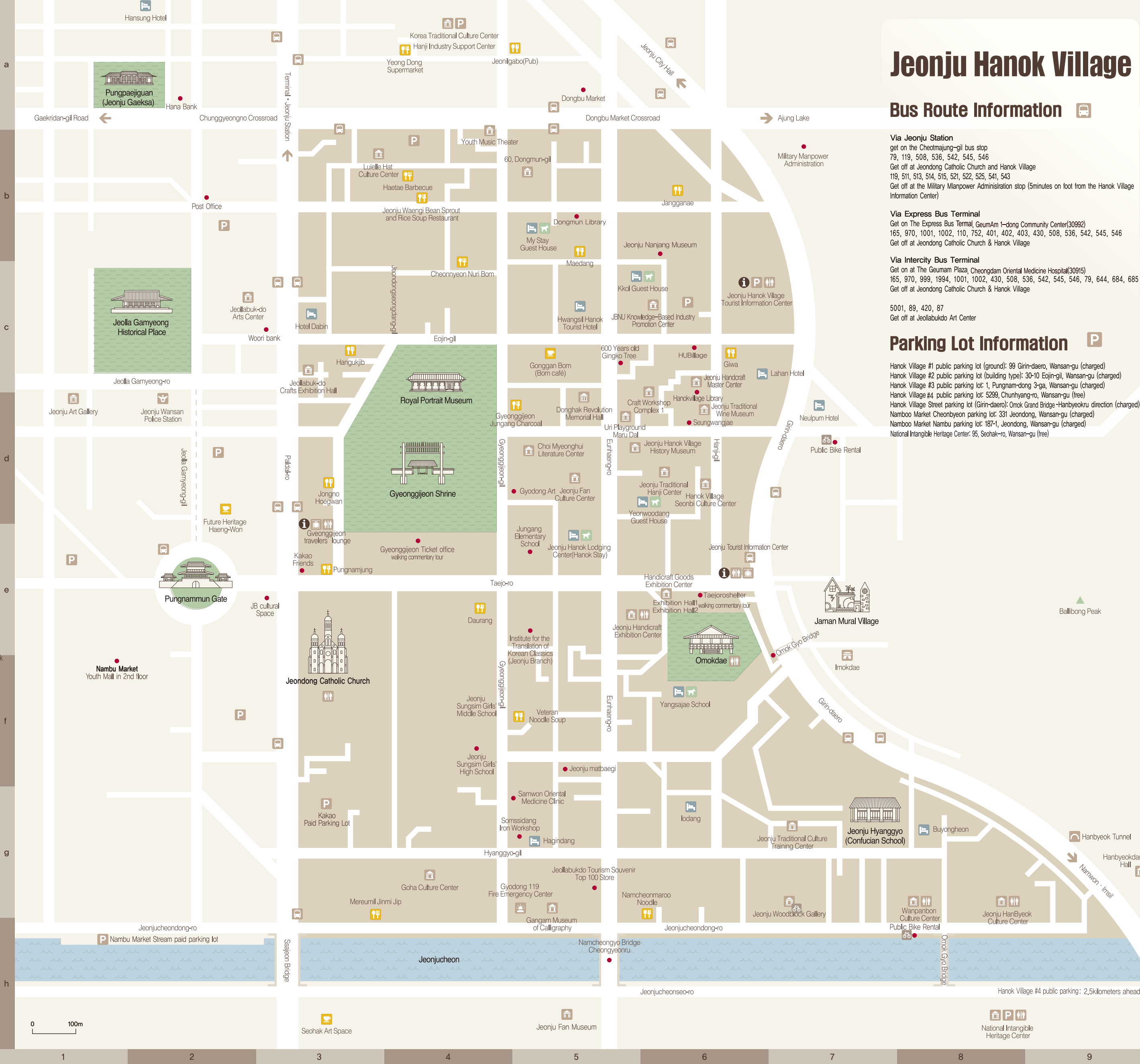
Hanji crafts, Hanji making tools, as well as ancient documents and books are on display, and you can also try making Hanji (Traditional Korean paper) yourself.

Chuseok Museum & Lullaby Culture Center b3
On the first floor of the Memory Museum, Nostalgia takes us on a trip back to the past. You can enjoy looking at many school props and childhood toys. On the second floor, you can look around and try on various hats from different eras, places, and countries.

Jeonju Nanjang Museum b6
It is a place where you can take pictures, and have fun with props from the past, which are so realistically reproduced it's as if you have gone back in time. It represents a unique experience, full of memories and nostalgia.

Jeondong Catholic Church f3
51, Taejo-ro, Wansan-gu, Jeonju-si
Jeondong Catholic Church, built from 1907 to 1914, is the cradle of faith that preserves the many-story site. It is said that the foundation stones of the church were taken from the demolished walls of Pungnammun Gate, the place of execution of the 28th year of King Sejo's reign. It is Jeollabuk-do Hanan's first example of Romanesque and Byzantine style beauty and grandeur, that maximized the use of curves, is one of the most incredible religious structures in the East.

Namcheong Bridge Cheongyeon h5
Namcheong Bridge, located in Donggok-dong, was the gateway of Jeonju Hanok Village. It is located in the center of Jeonju Hanok Village and is one of the most beautiful spots in the village. Many people enjoy taking pictures with famous cartoon characters as the backdrop.

Future Heritage Haeng-Won d2
This building was used as a gyeongju calligraphy in the past. A lady painter Namgong Heo Saeh-oh took over and operated it as a restaurant. Currently, it is used as a Hanok cafe. It has served as the cradle of culture and art as a popular place for cultural artists of the time. (Editor's note: the name of the 'lady painter' appears constantly)

Jaman Mural Village e7
It was a poor village inhabited by refugees during the Korean War, but it has become a trendy spot featuring beautifully-painted murals. Many people enjoy taking pictures with famous cartoon characters as the backdrop.

Jeonju Hanok Village f3

44, Taejo-ro, Wansan-gu, Jeonju-si

Gyeonggijeon Shrine d4
44, Taejo-ro, Wansan-gu, Jeonju-si
The building was constructed in 1410 the 10th year of King Taejo's reign to enshrine King Taejo's portrait, after the founding of the Joseon Dynasty. The place where King Taejo was enshrined was called Gyeonggijeon, and Taejojeon, and in 1442 the Tangle Cultural Property No. 15 and is commonly referred to as Hanbyeokdang, Hanbyeokcheongjeon has long been regarded as one of the Eight Scenes Views of Jeonju. Poets recited poems and enjoyed the breeze.

Pungnammun Gate e2
South-facing Pungnam Gate is the only remaining gate among the four main gates of the Jeonju fortress in Jeongju, Treasure No. 308. It was damaged during the Jeongju Gyeonju War, subsequently restored, and then burned down during the reign of King Yeongjo. It was named Pungnam Gate when it was restored during the reign of King Yeongjo.

Omokdae/Imokdae f6,7
55, Ginn-daero, Wansan-gu, Jeonju-si
It was made famous as the place where Lee Seung-yeon held a banquet to celebrate the victory after returning from the Goryeo Dynasty. West Playground Marudal has two meanings, a space with a floor for people to mingle, and a space with the moon hanging at the end of the roof of a Hanok.

Nambu Market and Youth Mall f1
53, Pungnammun 3-gil, Wansan-gu, Jeonju-si
From delicious food to unique items, it is an essential tourist attraction in Jeonju. Even when it's crowded there is plenty of food to enjoy, and sights to see.
